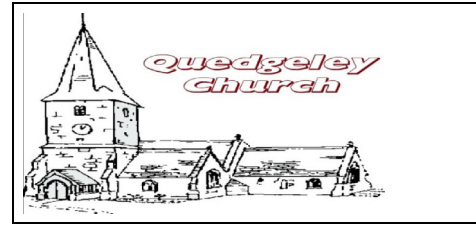

A change in the Law means there are 3 Forms in church regarding your rights which need your consideration & consent:

- 1) Permission to hold your contact details & how you wish to be contacted.
- 2) Permission for photographs to be taken & used on church media or publications.
- 3) Permission to inform your next of kin in case of accident or emergency happening in church or at church events.

Please read & consider these forms; if you are content, please sign & return them to Fr John.
